RESOLUTION 10-006 BANGOR TOWNSHIP RESOLUTION UPDATE SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR CEMETERY

The Board being fully advised, it is hereby moved by Ellis, seconded by Hoover, to adopt a Resolution as follows:

WHEREAS, Bangor Township, Ordinance No. 21, Section 4 sets forth a provision for the purchase of burial spaces and the transfer of one or more burial spaces from an original purchaser to a qualified assignee, and

WHEREAS, Section 4 further sets forth that the Township Board shall adopt by resolution a schedule of costs,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bangor Township Board adopts the following Schedule of Fees:
