## **HERE ARE THE RULES**

Nominations must be received by midnight July 1, 2009

- A person can only make one nomination.  
Nominations should include a picture and short essay (not more than 500 words telling me why your Mom should be chosen as Paw Paw's Bestest Mom Ever!
- No age limit on the person entering their Mom.
- No age limit of the Mom being entered as long as the Mom is living.
- Moms or the person entering their Mom must live in the greater Paw Paw Area.
- Entries may be handwritten or typed.
