## **NASH DRAIN COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP DAY OF REVIEW INFORMATION**

The Nash drain was established in 1891 along with the drainage district. The Nash drain is .3 miles in length.

### **Maintenance 2007-2009**

Maintenance on the Nash drain consisted of open channel clean-out of sediment, fallen trees and debris. The Nash drain outlets into Little Bear Lake and had lost its connection. Prior to maintenance water would flood 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and properties north and south of the road.

The total maintenance cost was \$7,825 from 2007 to 2009. In efforts to lessen the yearly assessment cost were spread over a 4 year time frame. The County and Columbia Township are paying at-large assessments totaling 50% of the cost. The remaining 50% of the cost are spread over the 17 parcels in the drainage district.
