



## **Reclassification of “35 m.p.h. Normal Loading” roads in Van Buren County**

All Van Buren County roads that were previously listed as “35 m.p.h. Normal Loading” on our Weight Restricted Road System were reclassified as of 3/22/2004.

### **Reclassified County Class “A” Roads (Normal loading and speed).**

### **County Roads eligible for a Special “Over Weight” permit**

The Van Buren County Road Commission will consider issuing “Overweight” permits for the following roads **only**. There will still be a speed restriction of 35 m.p.h. on all county roads that are not rated as class “A” roads. The overweight permit must be applied for from the Lawrence office and once issued must be carried in the cab of **each** truck authorized to operate on the roads listed below. The permit **will only** be for the road indicated on the permit. This permit should not be construed as authorizing overweight loads on any road not listed on the permit. Failure to produce the permit on request of a Weigh Master, Motor Carrier Officer or Police Officer will result in the issuance of a citation for overweight and/or permit violations.
